Toddler Twirlers Program

Our Toddler Twirlers Program is designed for our youngest twirlers & dancers, ages 18 months - 2 years. This program is full of singing, dancing, and playing as we explore creative dance concepts such as SIZE, SPEED, SHAPE, and more! These classes emphasize creativity, social and emotional growth, movement, and are FUN! Mini-sessions will be offered, at various times throughout the year, as this is not a September-May commitment. It is optional for the Toddler Twirlers to perform in the Spring Recital.

Twirly Tots Preschool Program

Our Twirly Tot Preschool Program is designed for twirlers & dancers, ages 2-5 years. This program introduces children to the world of twirling and dance in a fun, nurturing, and creative environment. Through imaginative play and age-appropriate activities, children will develop motor skills, coordination, and musicality. Our instructors use engaging methods to foster a love for twirling and dance at a young age. The Twirly Tot Preschool Program helps build confidence, social skills, and is a strong foundation for future training. The Twirly Tots WILL perform in the Christmas show and Spring recital.
